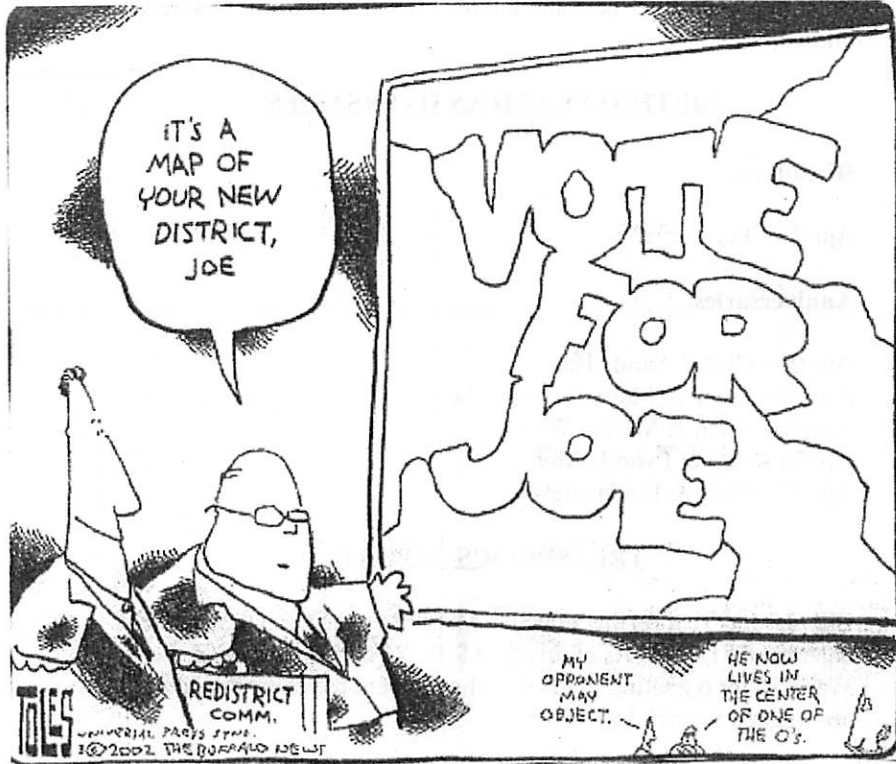


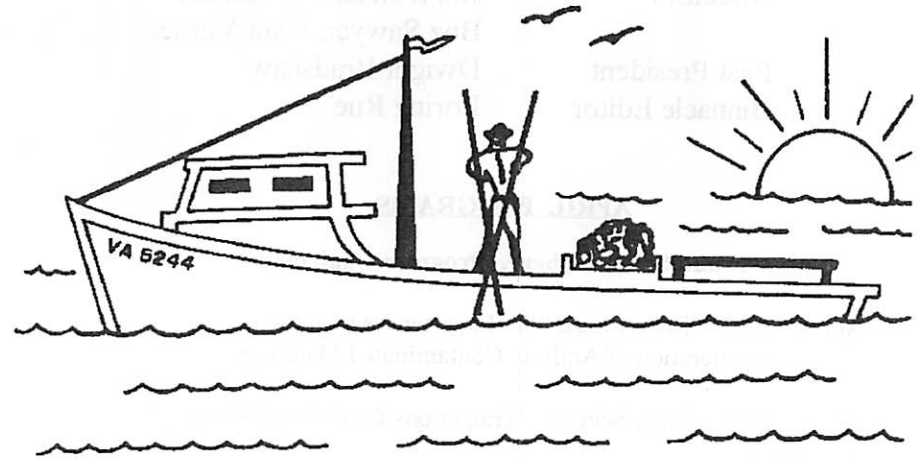
ATTENDANCE
