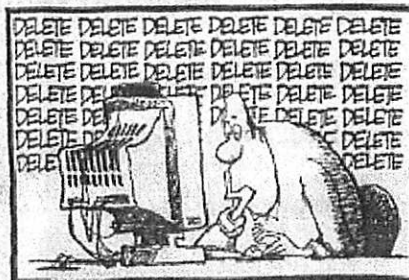
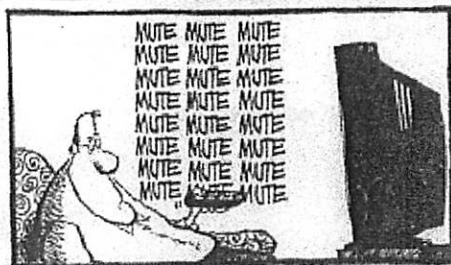

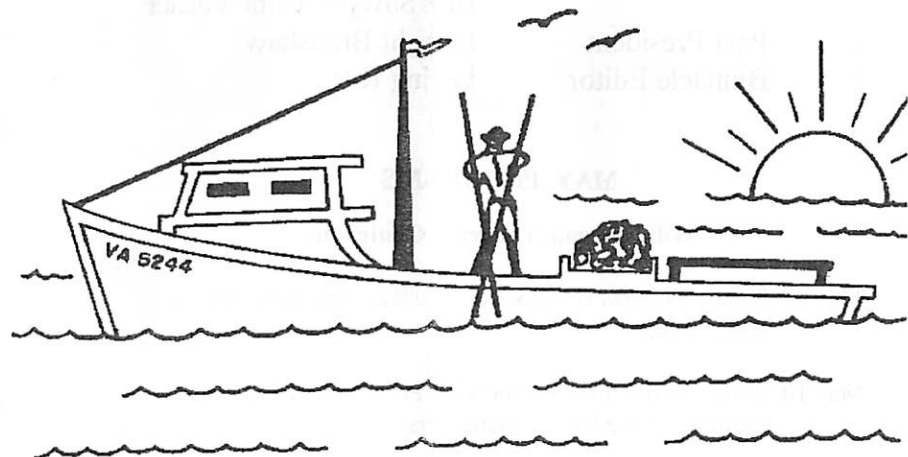
**NEW MEMBER**
