This seems to be an appropriate time of the year for all of us to carefully consider and practice the four tenets of Rotary:

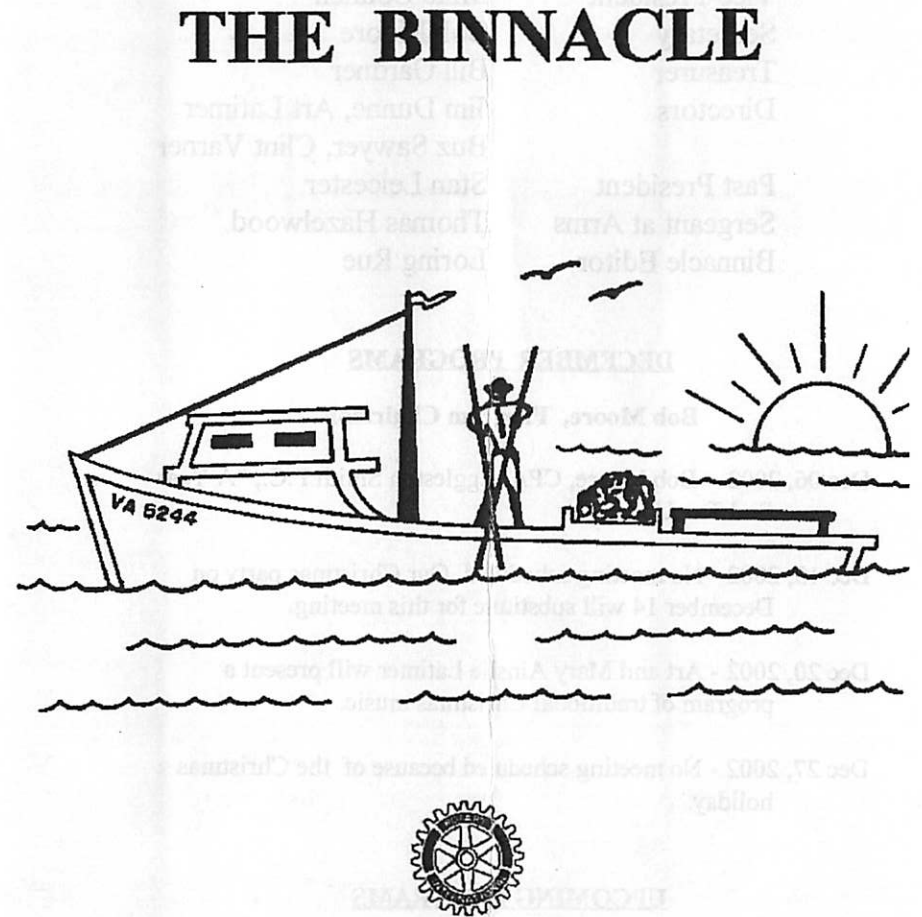
- IS IT THE TRUTH?
