The term "Four Avenues of Service" is frequently used in Rotary literature and information. The "Avenues" refer to the four elements of the Object of Rotary: Club Service, Vocational Service, Community Service and International Service.

Although the Avenues of Service are not found in any formal part of the constitutional documents of Rotary, the concept has been accepted as a means to describe the primary areas of Rotary activity.

Community Service-pertains to those activities that Rotarians undertake to improve the quality of life in their community. It infrequently involves assistance to youth, the aged, handicapped and others who look to Rotary as a source of hope for a better life.

International Service-describes the many programs and activities that Rotarians undertake to advance international understanding, goodwill and peace. International Service projects are designed to meet humanitarian needs of of people in many lands.
