Standard Rotary Club Constitution

Rotary International is the most territorial organization in the world. It exists in 159 countries and cuts across dozens of languages, political and social structures, customs, religions and traditions. How is it that all of the more than 29,000 Rotary clubs of the world operate almost identical.

One of the conditions to receive a charter to become a Rotary club is to accept the Standard Club Constitution, originally adopted in 1922. The Standard Club Constitution outlines the administrative techniques for clubs to follow in holding weekly meetings, procedures for membership and classifications, conditions of attendance and payment of dues, and other policies relating to public issues and political positions.

When adopted in 1922, it was agreed that existing clubs could continue to follow their current constitution. Accordingly, a few pre-1922 clubs still conduct their club affairs according to their former constitutional provisions.

The Standard Club Constitution is one of Rotary's great strengths enabling the organization to operate in thousands of communities.
