RI World Headquarters

The headquarters of RI has always been around Chicago. First, it was in Chicago itself, but in 1954, RI moved into a new building in Evanston, IL. This building met RI needs until the 1980s when new programs such as Polio Plus and the growth of The Rotary Foundation made the headquarters extremely crowded and required supplemental space.

When a modern 18-story office building became available in downtown Evanston in 1987, it appeared to meet all of Rotary's space and expansion needs for years to come. RI purchased the building and leases approximately two-thirds of the space to commercial tenants until needed for future Rotary growth.

The building has a 190-seat auditorium, large parking garage and 300-seat cafeteria as well as functional office space for 400 plus employees. The executive suite on the 18th floor includes conferences rooms and offices for Rotary executives. The building is known as *One Rotary Center*.
